Please attach your abstract in Microsoft Word format. Abstracts must be submitted in English and should be no more than 300 words long. They must include the title, authors and their affiliation and mentor(s). Only one presenter per abstract will be accepted. Please underline the main author or presenter and specify your preference for an oral or poster presentation. The presentations will be in the following format: precollege students (poster only), undergraduate students (poster or oral) and graduate students (oral only).

The deadline for Undergraduate, Pre-College and Graduate Abstracts to be considered for Symposium Awards is August 4, 2015.

Abstracts received after **August 4, 2015** will NOT be considered for any cash prizes presented by the **AGMUS 2015 Research Symposium**, but will be tagged as **Late Submission Abstract** in the Symposium Proceedings. **The abstract submission site will be closed at midnight, August 4, 2015.**

- Boards will be available for posters not larger than 3x4 feet in portrait format.
- No audiovisual equipment, laptops or tables will be allowed with no EXCEPTIONS
